

# USING US15 KEYBOARD

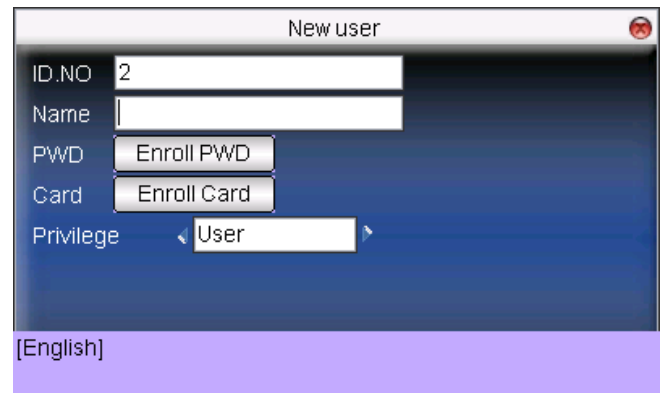
Alphabet letters or symbols can be entered on a US15 series keypad for configuring user names on the terminal, writing SMS messages, as well as entering Wi-Fi passwords manually.

## Alphabets

On the **New User** screen at **Name** field press the arrow key on the keypad. You will see a purple bar appear at the bottom of the screen with **[English]** label on it.

- Pressing corresponding key will reveal lower and uppercase characters
- Pressing 0 1 2 3...7 will type assigned character

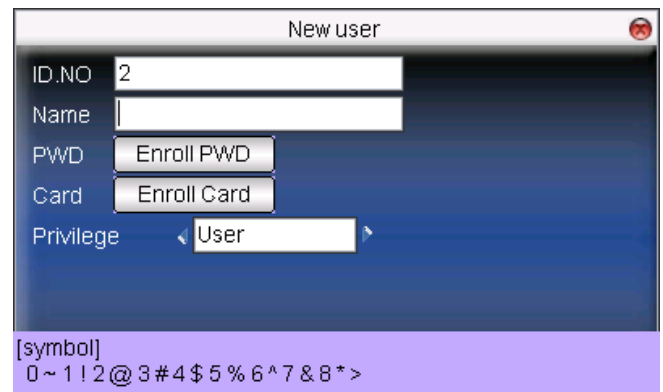
## Symbols & Invisible characters

On the **New User** screen at **Name** field press the arrow key on the keypad. You will see a purple bar appear at the bottom of the screen with **[English]** label on it. Pressing the arrow key **once more** will change the label to **[symbol]**.

- By Default** 0~ 1! 2@ 3# 4\$ 5% 6^ 7& 8\* displays.
- Pressing button will reveal more symbols.
